

## NIKO HOME CONTROL TRAINING SYLLABUS

### Day 1

Following a general introduction to Niko and the home automation system, you will learn about:

- The fundamentals of the Niko Smart Home installation and how it can implement with your installation.
- How Niko fits into the current market as the **Modern Electrical Installation**.
- Designing a system including advice on client meetings.
- General programming of lighting control incorporating switches and mood displays.
- Ventilation, heating and motor control functionality.

### Day 2

Building on your basic knowledge of the Niko Home Control system, you will learn about:

- Detailed design and planning elements. Also sales techniques and project delivery.
- Advanced programming including smart phone / iPad integration and touchscreen
- Integration of the functionality learned in Day 1 i.e. heating turned down when you arm your alarm and lights to turn on when the fire alarm activates
- Energy monitoring (water, gas, electricity, solar PV)
- Logical functions / conditions i.e. if – then scenarios. For example, in the evening, the bathroom light operates at 100% but at 2am it operates at 10%.
- **On completion of the course you will be registered as an approved installer.**
